TRAVEL FOR PARTICIPANTS	All participants (except those attending pre symposium curtain raiser events) are expected to arrive in Nairobi on Tuesday, 14 October 2025, and depart on Saturday, 18 October 2025. For eligible staff, the respective UNFPA country offices
	will cover travel tickets, DSA and terminal costs.
DSA / PER DIEM	The per diem rate for Nairobi, Kenya in October will be calculated to the prevailing UN rate at that time. UNFPA will cover all conference-related costs including morning and afternoon tea breaks and group lunches during the meeting days. There will be no group dinner; participants are free to make their own dining arrangements.

Travellers immunised against yellow fever are issued an internationally recognised certificate for inspection by immigration officials.
